Transportation

Bus shuttle to downtown, taxis, limos and pedicabs are available at the port. Sightseeing cars, vans and limos are also available. The shuttle service is provided a minimum of every 20 minutes to and from downtown. These services drop passengers near the Empress Hotel and the gateway to Victoria's shopping and business district. Last shuttle service is one hour prior to ships sailing time. Look for the blue "Cruise Victoria" motor coaches upon arrival.

Shopping

James Bay Village, at Menzies and Simcoe, will satisfy your food, beverage, pharmaceutical, postal and banking needs.

Government St. is where you will find the best of the city's Canadian West Coast and British Imports, plus all kinds of gifts and souvenirs for friends and family back home.

Community Markets

James Bay Community Market is close to the Cruise Ship terminal and just two blocks south of the Inner Harbour. It's open 9am - 3pm every Saturday from May to October. Whether you're hunting for handmade arts and crafts or relaxing to local music with a coffee and fresh baked goods, it's a great way to spend an afternoon.

Government St Market is located on Government just north of Johnson. It's open on Sundays and offers a wide variety of island products and services.

Night Market at Ship Point is right on the Inner Harbour and open, weather permitting, Friday and Saturday evenings from 7pm - 10pm from June 18 - Sept 18. There you will discover everything from clothing and jewelry, to local arts, crafts and music.
